The 2012 Promenade Stages Rally, organised by Wallasey Motor Club and sponsored for a second year by AVO Performance Suspension (www.avouk.com) will take place on Friday 7th and Saturday 8th September. The Friday night Floodlit Super Special, introduced in 2011 to celebrate the 30th Anniversary of the event, is running again this year. The stage has been extended for 2012 and with reverse seeding & two cars starting (and hopefully, finishing) side by side, the evening should build to a climax around 10pm as the top crews compete against each other.

The Saturday comprises of 10 stages covering nearly 50 competitive miles on the closed public roads of King's Parade, New Brighton in Wirral and finishes by 6pm.

Marshals are need for both Friday & Saturday so if you are available and would like to assist, please let me know. Every marshal signed on will receive a goodie bag and there will be a marshals' prize draw during the day on Saturday. For Friday, marshals' signing on is from 15:30 with the first cars due on stage at 17:30 so marshals should be in place by 17:00. If you are available to come earlier though to help with the setup of the stage or service area that would be even better!

On Saturday, signing on is from 06:15 with the first car due on stage at 08:15. The roads are closed at 07:00 so ideally marshals should be in place by then. To be completed by every guest participating in activities associated with Clwyd Vale Motor Club.

Please read below then print name and sign.

- I can confirm that I am familiar with the nature of the activity, which I wish to undertake and acknowledge the risks involved.
- I declare that I am in good health and that I am not suffering from any medical condition or disability
 which is likely to make it unsafe for me to participate in this activity. I can confirm that I'm between 5
 ft 6ft 2" in height and of medium build. I understand that the organisers reserve the right to refuse
 rides to persons that are outside of these sizes and do not fit in to the seat correctly.
- I accept that I shall be solely responsible for any decision as to my fitness to participate in this activity.
 I also understand that Clwyd Vale Motor Club reserves the right to remove me from the venue if it considers my actions to be dangerous or detrimental to other venue users.
- I understand that I am to act in a responsible manner and in the interest of health and safety will follow
 the directions of the marshals and the organisers at all times. Persons acting in a dangerous manner
 will be asked to leave without refund.
- I am over the age of 16 and I must carry a valid ticket, sign in and attend a briefing before entering the rally car.
- I understand that the harnesses will need to be correctly fitted by a marshal, some adjustments to the
 harnesses may be require and I will help by following the instructions of the marshal in completing
 this task. Harnesses will be checked for tension by doing a hand test in the front shoulder (collarbone)
 area.
- I agree to wear a crash helmet and I will be required to wear a long sleeve upper garment, long trousers
 and sturdy footwear before entering the rally car.
- Each passenger will be allocated the next available a car to ride in. The organisers will not enter into
 any discussion about this decision.
- I agree that the drivers reserve the right to refuse a passenger and terminate the ride if it is felt that the
 passenger is causing a danger or hazard to the car/driver or to themselves and that the organiser's
 judgments are final.
- I agree that if my cheque is returned due to lack of funds that a £10 administration fee will apply.
- While attending the event I herby acknowledge that I do so entirely at my own risk and that no claim
 of any kind arising from my own negligence, injudicious act or omission or otherwise shall be made
 by me or on behalf of any of my dependants against Clwyd Vale Motor Club or any of the following

AVS Motorsport Cambrian Rally 2012

North Wales Car Club announce the opening of entries for the **AVS Motorsport** Cambrian Rally 2012, final round of the BTRDA, WAMC and ANWCC championships.

The event, being held on 20th October, offers nearly 45 miles of stages, using Clocaenog and Penmachno forests and finishing with the infamous Great Orme asphalt stage.

All the details, including the regulations and entry form, are on www.cambrianrally.co.uk

Following last year's comments we are using only the best of the forest roads and are working closely with the Forestry Commission to ensure that they are in prime condition for our event.

There will be centralised servicing in Ruthin where full facilities will be available to competitors and service personnel.

To encourage your early entry we would advise that cheques will not be banked until the closing date, which is 5th October. So, if you're planning to enter then please submit your entry early so that we can plan fully for the event.

Anyone who needs to withdraw by that date will have their cheque returned, anyone withdrawing after that date will be given a guaranteed refund, with only a discretionary small amount charged for any administration costs incurred by us.

Facilities to pay by Paypal (extra charge) or Bank Transfer are also available, using our online entry system.
